Bridge Club of North County

If you are a beginning to intermediate bridge player, you need to check out all the activities underway at our club. No matter what you're looking for, we've got you covered!

For beginners there are classes and workshops presented by Hazel Turner who is a Life Master and ACBL certified bridge teacher.

The second series in our Audrey Grant based lessons, is scheduled to begin on Saturday, January 12th, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in the BCNC, Escondido clubhouse. Continuing where Bridge Basics 1 left off, this course provides detailed coverage of areas that come up in competitive auctions, such as preemptive opening calls, overcalls and advances, takeout doubles and advances, and the competitive auction. The cost is \$99 for the 8 weekly sessions and includes the Bridge Basics 2 book. Use the Contact Us, Education Coordinator link on the BCNC website to register for the class.

Our weekly bridge workshops for beginning/intermediate players will begin again on Thursday, January 10th. This next series will focus on defense. The schedule is as follows: Jan 10 – Opening Leads Against No Trump Contracts, Jan 17 – Opening Leads Against Suit Contracts, Jan 24 – Third Hand Play, Jan 31 – Second Hand Play, Feb 7 – Defensive Signals, Feb 14 – Developing Defensive Tricks, Feb 21 – Interfering With Declarer, Feb 28 – Making a Plan. You don't need to be enrolled in any class to participate in the workshops, and you can come whenever a topic is of interest to you. Our Wednesday mornings at 9:00 a.m., we have a 0-149 game for beginning to intermediate players. This is a very friendly game, with lots of opportunity for learning and practicing bridge skills. We regularly have 5-7 tables of wonderful, happy people having fun! Game fee is \$8.

Concurrently, on Wednesday mornings, we offer a 0-20 Introductory game. If you're new to bridge, this is the game for you. It was specifically designed for entry level players to practice their newly acquired skills in a no pressure, relaxed environment. This game has a mentor available to answer questions and monitor the play. It is <u>not</u> required that you have attended BCNC classes to play in this game – only that you

are familiar with the basic bridge game and you hold no more than 20 masterpoints. For this particular game you don't need to arrive with a partner. You can just come – we'll arrange a partner for you. Game fee is \$5.

Anyone whose masterpoint earnings are within the game range limits for either of the two Limited MP games listed above is invited to play. If you are interested, please email Dorothea Williams at <u>dorotheaw@cox.net</u> to register.

There are 0-499 games each Monday and Friday morning at 9:00 a.m. Also, for advanced beginning and intermediate players, we offer mentoring sessions called "Supervised Play" every Monday and Tuesday morning at 9:00 a.m. Sessions last about 2 ½ hours. I just got back from a visit to Montana, where just like here, the winter has been unusually wet and cold. PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Our unit is part of ACBL District 22, and David Lodge is our representative to the Board of Directors. After each Board meeting, he usually sends the unit presidents a summary of the meeting. His last summary sort of caught my attention when he started it with the following: "One of the realities of life is that a great deal of time of the BOD is spent on high level tournament play. Such was the case in Memphis where much of the BOD activities centered around cheating at the national (international level)."

Call me naive, call me unrealistic, call me out of touch, call me whatever, I have a hard time getting my head around the fact that there is a lot of cheating in duplicate bridge. It sort of takes away the aura surrounding those people playing behind the curtain at these big tournaments. When I read in the Bridge Bulletin about the really clever bidding sequence that took place for the winning hand at the national tournament, it sort of makes me wonder if it was really that clever.

In the same vein, a Washington Post headline on March 1st read: "Doping scandal rocks the world of ... bridge?". The World Bridge Federation regularly drug tests participants in their big tournament games and imposes penalties on those who fail the test. Amazingly it was reported that 22% of those tested test positive for a banned substance. In this particular case Geir Helgemo, a Norwegian-born player who plays for the Monaco team, was suspended for a year for doping with a synthetic testosterone.

Back to bridge here at home: our unit is number one in the district for adding new members to the ACBL. This is in large part due to the great work Hazel and others are doing with the beginner bridge program. I ran into Wirt at the Regional, and he is still struggling to find a place with adequate parking. So it appears Adventures in Bridge won't be reopening for a while.

Bridge Club of North County

Are you a "bridge thief"? What's that, you ask? If you regularly take longer than the time allowed to finish the hands in a round, you are a bridge thief. It means you "steal" time from your fellow players who come to the table after you, by limiting the amount of time they have to finish the next round on time. The clock does not reset for them when you take too long to finish. This gives you an unfair advantage. Bridge is a timed event. Thinking and acting quickly is part of the skill. Did you know the BCNC has a Club Policy regarding "slow play"? It's in Section 4.3.5 of the Club Handbook. There are two statements in this section you should be cognizant of: 1) Slow play, especially habitual slow play, is a violation of law and subject to penalty. And 2) If the opening lead is not on the table when the round is called (by the director OR the clock) the hand should not be played and a No Play should be issued. The Club Policy is posted on the Club News bulleting board. There is also an article from ACBL about this subject on the Bridge News bulletin board. There is really no excuse for habitual slow play and the penalties given are well earned when slow play pairs disrupt the normal progression of the game.

The Community Corner bulletin board is becoming more and more the place to hang out while you wait for your table to be available or you just have some time to kill. There are lots of good recommendations for local tradespeople, some interesting doings of our club members, and even some funny stuff! By the way, you are all invited to post things there. Anything you might want to share, so long as it's "clean", and not commercial advertising. If you post a recommendation, please put your name on the notice so anyone who's interested could talk to you about it. You can list requests for partnerships there as well.

Don't forget to turn in your recommendation chit for "Player of the Month". If you know someone who is delightful to have at a bridge table, who always makes you feel welcome and appreciated, who you think is a great partner (maybe not yours, but anyone's), fill out one of those yellow slips and get your friends to do the same. Remember now, it's a combo event, which means that our Winter Sectional will run concurrently – in the same location as the NLM Regional. It will be held at St. Gabriel's Catholic Church Auditorium, 13734 Twin Peaks Road, Poway, CA 92064. There will be two sessions for each event both days of the tournament. The NLM Regional will offer 0-750 "Gold Rush" 2-session games and single session side games (all stratified C: 0-200, B:200-500, A:500-750). The Sectional (for silver points) will also offer 2 sessions per day also with no requirement to play in both sessions each day. In addition to the Open Section (C:0-2000, B:2000-4000, A:4000 +), there will be a 0-1500 Section (C:0-500, B:500-1000, A:1000-1500). Games will start at 10 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. Entry fee for each session is \$13. Lunch will be available for purchase at \$7. Players with 0-20 MPS play free!
